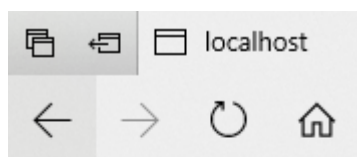


To study the use of ARRAY in PHP.

OUTPUT :

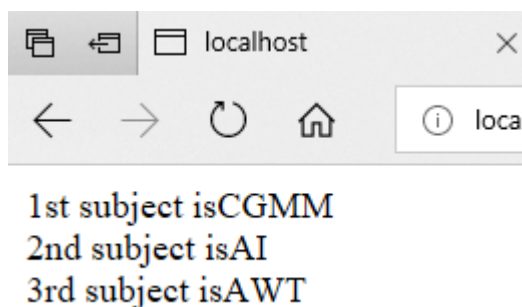


apple
